QUICK REMINDER OF OUR ROUTINES AND EXPECTATIONS FROM PARENTS

While we were flexible in enforcing some of the school rules, it is important to reiterate areas of attention.

HOME FUN: We are all busy people, but we must as a matter of importance, put a routine in place whereby children are engaged in their home study (homework, reading etc.) at designated times of the day. One of the ways to establish routine for children is to ensure that they have a scheduled time for home fun, E-book, and minimized TV time. REVIEW OF SOME OF THE ACTIVITIES FOR THE TERM

The Early Years Theme for this term was **‘Flowers and Recycling’**. During the course of the term, our pupils were exposed to the different kinds of flowers and equally learnt a lot about recycling and how to re-use items to make new things to make our planet a beautiful place to live and grow.



EARLY YEARS FRIENDSHIP DAY: The Early Years kick started the term with Friendship Day. Friendship Day was an excellent opportunity to provide Pupils with lessons and advice on fostering friendships and explaining the importance of friendships. Teachers used that opportunity to deliver lessons on the following topics:

- Identifying characteristics of a good friend.
- Practicing skills and language which makes people friends.
- Read books with moral discussions about friendships.

Fostering good friendships has a huge impact on children’s and adults’ wellbeing. Good friendships help children develop a moral compass and teach them how to interact acceptably in social situations. It was such a fantastic topic to unveil the agenda for the term for our Early Years Treasures.



The theme for Primary Section this term was **“World Heroes”**. All class activities and learning were centered around this theme. It was an exhilarating and rewarding experience as the Pupils learnt about the life and times of ordinary men and women; mostly from humble backgrounds who strived and succeeded in changing the narratives thereby transforming to World Heroes. They also learnt life lessons that will be indispensable all through their life journey.

At Evergreen British School, our aim is to develop a total child who will become a responsible member of the society as an adult.

YEAR ONE: Year one had numerous interesting class activities this term. The highlight of this term activity centered on the South American Heroes. Pupils came to school dressed as some of these Heroes and made presentations on significant roles they played. Joan Baez was one of the first musicians to use her popularity as a vehicle for social protest. Pele was widely regarded as one of the greatest footballers of all time. Ellen Laura Ochoa was the first Hispanic woman to go to space. Doleres Clara Fernandez Huerta is a labour leader and civil rights activist.



YEAR TWO: The Pupils had presentations on North American Heroes and the contributions they made to the world. Some of the heroes in focus were Rosa Parks, Martin Luther King Jr, Albert Einstein, George Washington, Susan Anthony, Jackie Robinson and a whole lot of others. They also had another presentation on transportation and road safety guidelines both for pedestrians and drivers as well. Pupils also learnt how to observe traffic lights and its usefulness to the stability and proper functioning of the society.



YEAR THREE: Year Three made a presentation on European Heroes. Some of the Heroes in focus were Marie Curie: the first woman to win a Nobel Prize in two science subjects. Alexander the Great; he laid the foundation for the spread of democracy. Julius Caser: he created the Julian calendar which is the basis of the Roman Calendar used today. Aletta Jacobs: first woman to officially attend a Dutch University and became one of the first female physicians in the Netherlands.



YEAR FOUR: Year Four took this term's presentation to higher dimension by teaching other Pupils about Tourism around the World.

They graciously took us through different tourist attractions around the world, the importance of tourism and characteristics of tourism. Tourist attractions around the world, year four took us to were the Colosseum in Rome, Eiffel Tower in Paris, the Taj Mahal in India and the Pyramids in Egypt.



YEAR FIVE: Year Five presentation was focused on Asian Heroes and Heroines. Examples of some of these heroes were Junko Tabei - first female mountaineer to climb mount Everest. IM Pei - an Architect known for building outstanding houses. King Bhumbol; who ruled for 70 years and 126 days. Dr David Ho – a Doctor of HIV/AIDS.

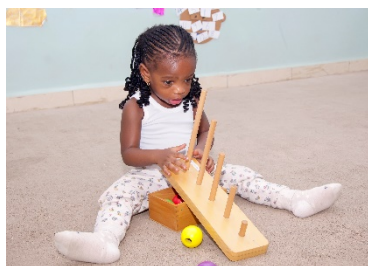
